Quality assurance

- Monitoring authority
 - Standards for recognition of teachers and institutions
 - Program for quality assurance
 - Monitoring systems for quality control
- Requirements for training institutions
 - Rules about recognition of institutions, size, diversity, admissions and organization of institutions (out-, inpatient)
 - Quality control of institutions

- Requirements for teachers
 - Practising time in speciality, specific training programs, ratio teacher/trainees
- Requirements for trainees
 - Sufficient numbers of clinical cases
 - Sufficient lingustic ability to communicate with patients as well as international litterature and collegues
 - Training according to a log book

Ongoing working group activities

- Summary of present state of training guidelines in Europe
- Using the work that already has been done in some countries, translating their updated guidelines
 - Present them at CAP UEMS web site

Goals of the process: (CAP UEMS meeting Aug 22 2009)

- A revision of present training guidelines, "good enough" EU standards – presented at next CAP UEMS meeting in one year
- More focus on quality assurance
